ATTENTION

1. For indoor use only.
2. You are advised to wear protective gloves when assembling the desk.
3. Do not fully tighten bolts until you have completed assembly.
4. It is highly recommended that you assemble the desk on a carpeted floor surface so as to prevent scratches.
5. It is highly recommended that you adjust the desk to its lowest height before moving.
6. Before lifting the desk, check if surroundings are clear and make sure desk power cord is able to move freely as the desk moves up and down.
7. Do not spray cleaning solutions directly onto table system, clean only with a dry or slightly damp cloth.
8. Do not open electrical components.
9. Keep all electrical components away from water and high humidity.
10. Do not modify the plug provided with the product.
11. To disconnect, turn off all the power supply before removing the adapter from the outlet.
12. Check the desk parts on a monthly basis to ensure they are still functioning correctly.
13. Children are forbidden to play on the product because of unforeseen action when playing, so many dangerous consequences caused by this improper action will not be on manufacturers.




1. Insert the extendable bar (long) to 2 extendable bars (short).

2. Do not fix them with screws before completing the frame assembly.





Install the frame supports (left & right) to the extendable bar (finished in step 1) with 8 pcs M6x16mm screws. (5mm Allen Key)





Install the side bracket to the frame with 4 pcs M6x12mm screws. (5mm Allen Key)





Install the frame base to frame support with 8 pcs M6 x 45mm screws. (5mm Allen Key)





Install the desktop to the desk frame with 8 pcs shims and 10pcs ST5x20 screws.




Install the extendable coupling rod to the desk frame and do not tighten the rod.





Install the controller to the desk top with 2 pcs ST3.5X13mm screws.



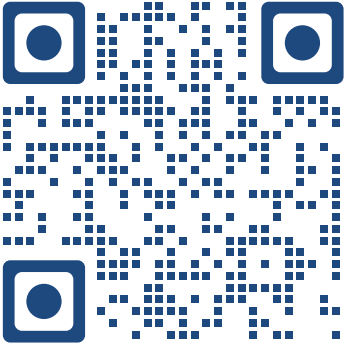
1. Connect the cable from motor to controller.

CONTROLLER INSTRUCTIONS



Reset Setting	Press "V" and "^" buttons together on the controller for 4 seconds, it will show "000", until you hear the beep release the buttons. The desk will automatically go down slowly. (It will have a rebound and rise about 5 mm/0.2in) until it shows "69" and when you hear the beep, the reset is successful.
Height Adjustment	Up: Press "^" button. Down: Press "V" button.
Switch Display	Press 2 times "V" when the desk is at the lowest position to switch cm to inch.
Memory Height	Press and hold any of memory buttons (1,2,3 or 4) until you hear a beep. Release the button, and this position height will be stored in memory. When the working height of memory needs to be used, press the memory position button and the desk will automatically adjust to the memory height. Note: This standing desk has 4 different height memories. The memory positions stored are still valid after power off. You can use the up and down buttons to adjust the standing desk to the height you need to work.

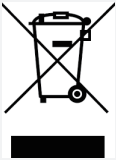

COMMON FAULT TREATMENT

CODE	Description	Method
E02	Motor overcurrent	Press "V" or "^" button again, if it still persist, please replace the motor or reduce the load
E03	Motor Hall failure	Press "V" or "^" button again, if it still persist, please check the connection or replace the motor
E04	The main power supply is abnormal	After power off, if it can not be eliminated, please replace the power supply
E05	Motor current is abnormal	After power off, if it can not be eliminated, please contact with your supplier or dealer
E06	Motor power device is damaged	After power off, if it can not be eliminated, please contact with your supplier or dealer
E09	Motor stalled	Press "V" or "^" button again, if it still persist, please replace the motor or reduce the load
E10	Anti-pinch triggering	
Hot	The motor is working too long time	1- Wait 18 mins, the code will disappear automatically 2- Unplug the power supply and power back on
RST	Illegal power off	Reset the program
